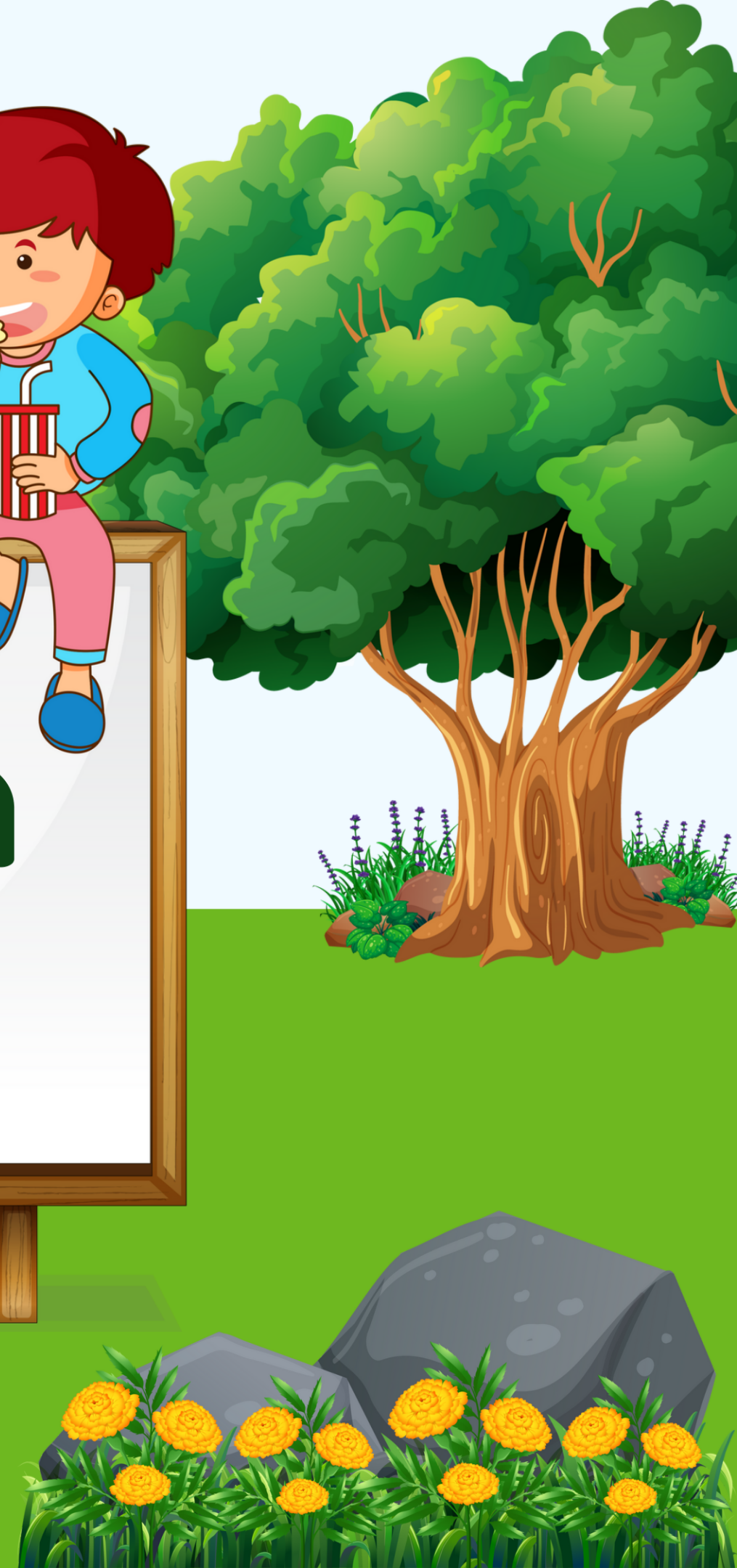

# IMPORTANT TO LEARN ENGLISH

## 1. LEARN BASIC WORDS

START WITH EVERYDAY WORDS LIKE:

COLORS: RED, BLUE, YELLOW, GREEN

ANIMALS: CAT, DOG, BIRD, FISH

THINGS AROUND YOU: BOOK, PENCIL, TABLE, CHAIR

PEOPLE: TEACHER, FRIEND, FAMILY, STUDENT



## 2. Practice Saying Simple Sentences

- Use simple sentences to talk about your day:

- "My name is [Your Name]."
- "I like [your favorite food]."
- "This is my [pet/friend]."
- "I am happy!" or "I am tired."



### 3. Learn to Ask Questions

- Practice asking and answering questions:
  - "What is your name?"
  - "How are you?"
  - "Where is your book?"
  - "Can I play with you?"





## 4. Play with Sounds and Letters

Learn the alphabet: A, B, C, D...

Practice phonics (sounds of letters).

For example:

"A" sounds like "apple."

"B" sounds like "ball."

Try saying the sounds of letters out loud!





## 5. LISTEN AND SING SONGS

**LISTEN TO SIMPLE ENGLISH SONGS AND SING ALONG. THIS HELPS WITH LEARNING NEW WORDS AND IMPROVING PRONUNCIATION.**

**EXAMPLE:**

**"TWINKLE, TWINKLE, LITTLE STAR" OR "THE WHEELS ON THE BUS."**
